LAMP 25 An introduction pt 2

We are pleased to present the LAMP study curriculum for 2025. The yearly programme includes four specific Aspects.

Aspect One includes 3 modules running at various times between January and the end of May. Each module comprises of four Tuesday evenings.

Aspect Two is a Summer Study Week held in June 2025. It will comprise of five different stand alone modules over the five day period.

Aspect Three takes place in the Autumn of the year and comprises of four separate stand alone modules taking place over four weekends, (Friday evening and Saturday). There will be one such module on the first weekend of each month between the months of September and December 2025.

The year will also see us hosting a special **Additional Conference Aspect** which will take the form of a unique duel faceted teaching Conference Day for those in Youth Leadership and for Young People themselves. Therefore it is two conferences in one venue at the same time. This Additional Youth Conference Aspect will take place on the first Saturday of June 2025.

MODULE NAME : OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY

Module No: L25/01

Course Period : Four Consecutive Tuesday Evenings Dates : February 4th, 11th, 18th & 25th Feb 2025 Format : In person for those living in Charnwood. (Online for those living further afield.) Course Fees: £30.00 for the 4 weeks

Module Overview:

In this module the student will discover the riches of the Old Testament exploring how it fits into the overall biblical story about God establishing His kingdom on earth. The four week course will

demonstrate a number of approaches to the Old Testament and introduces students to the culture, context, and content of each of the four sections of the Old Testament.

The course will highlight the key people, events, and periods in the Old Testament which will help to quickly build up a foundation of historical truth whilst at the same time offer inspiration and practical application. The general breakdown of the course is as follows :

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Week 1. Introduction & The History Books.

Week 2. The Wisdom Books.

Week 3. The Major Prophets.

Week 4. The Minor Prophets.

ASPECT ONE

MODULE NAME : NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY.

Module No: L25/02

Course Period : Four Consecutive Tuesday Evenings Dates : March 11th, 18th, 25th & Apr 1st 2025 Format : In person for those living in Charnwood. (Online for those living further afield.) Course Fees: £30.00 for the 4 weeks

Module Overview:

Similar to the Old Testament Survey course, in this module the student will discover the riches of the New Testament exploring how each section fits into the overall biblical story about God establishing His kingdom on earth. Students will survey and discover the message of the New Testament being introduced to its various approaches and to the four main sections of the Testament taking a deeper dive into its key characters, events, and periods. The course, as with all LAMP modules will again offer salient information that is married with Spirit filled inspiration and much personal and practical application. The general breakdown of the course is as follows:

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Week 1. Introduction & History. Week 2. Jesus & The Gospels. Week 3. Paul & The Epistles. Week 4. The Pastoral Epistles & Revelation.



MODULE NAME : PRINCIPLES OF EFFECTIVE LEADERSHIP

Module No: L25/03

Course Period : Four Consecutive Tuesday Evenings Dates : 29th April, & 6th, 20th, 27th May 2025. Format : In person for those living in Charnwood. (Online for those living further afield.) Course Fees: £30.00 for the 4 weeks Module Overview:

This course module is particularly designed to help participants to develop an understanding and develop effective leadership skills. The course comes from the standpoint that everything falls and stands on the quality of its leaders and that the Church desperately needs healed, mentored, equipped and released leaders, capable of spiritual reproduction and empowerment.

The course will cover the foundations of effective leadership as well as providing helpful tips for emerging, first time and more seasoned leaders to create a positive and motivational leadership style. Each of the four evenings will focus on how you can embrace and become a more creative, fruitful effectual and productive leader. The general breakdown of the course is as follows:

Week 1. The Leader's Heart Week 2. Leading the Jesus way Week 3. Small Group Dynamics – Leading Smaller Groups Week 4. Creating a Leadership Legacy - Identifying, coaching and developing other leaders.

ADDITIONAL ASPECT

ASPECT TWO

THE LAMP SUMMER SCHOOL

Module No: L25/04 - L25/08
Course Period : 5 separate study modules over a period of one week covering one stand alone module each day.
Dates : Monday June 23rd through to Friday June 27th 2025
Format : In person for those living in Charnwood. (Online for those living further afield.)

Course Fees: £125 for the week or £30 per day

The L.A.M.P. Summer School has pulled together an eclectic group of inspired and anointed lecturers from around the UK who are specifically gifted in their chosen fields. The teaching in these modules will meet you where you are and push your relationship and calling in God to a whole new level. As well as dynamic teaching, participants will share in group work, class discussion, social times, meals, devotions, reflections and one-on-one sessions.

MODULE NAME : EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION.

Date: Monday June 23rd 2025 Module Number: L25/04

Module Overview:

Effective communication changes lives and launches people into action! This module explores how to communicate with excellence and power in any given situation or setting. This powerful course contains teaching that is relevant for both veteran speakers, beginners and anyone who wants to grow as an effective speaker and leader. It will instruct students in the art of effective communication.

It takes the student through a process of preparation, developing a theme, giving it focus, and communicating it with confidence to an audience. It will build a greater desire in each student to become an effective communication practitioner.

MODULE NAME : WORLD FAITHS & CULTS

Date: Tuesday June 24th 2025 Module Number: L25/05

Module Overview :

Researchers inform us that around 85% of the world's population is religious. The module asks with a multitude of religious beliefs and practice, what makes Christianity so unique? In this module we will examine some of the major religions and cults in our society today. After a brief introduction to a number of groups, we will take a look at their core beliefs, comparing and contrasting them to the beliefs of biblical Christianity.

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Finally, we will consider how we might effectively engage members of these groups with the gospel. Excellent for people who have friends, co-workers, and neighbours of other faiths.

MODULE NAME : APOLOGETICS & Culture in the 21st century.

Date: Wednesday 25th June 2025 Module Number: L25/06

Module Overview :

This module explores various intellectual, social and religious trends that help to shape people's thinking in the 21st century. It will also present certain approaches to contempory apologetics. It will explore how we can defend the Christian faith sensitively, creatively and rigorously and with clarity considering a number questions and objections that are posed today in modern society.

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With creative insights, and using the Apostle Paul's approach to the subject as a base, this module prepares the student to share a defence of the Christian faith that is both plausible and desirable, offering clarity for those who have become disoriented in the haze of modern Western culture.

MODULE NAME : SOCIAL ENGAGEMENT AND THE GOSPEL

Date: Thursday 26th June 2025 Module Number: L25/07

Module Overview:

This module will introduce a biblical-theological vision of social and community engagement and social justice. It will also explore the tension between a grace and faith alone gospel and faith and works and the social Gospel. The course will further consider what the scriptures as a whole say and what the Lord Jesus Christ teaches about social and community engagement and the subject of justice. It will also evaluate the differences between Christian community engagment and charitable and social action undertaken by secular organisations.

The module will create a platform to discuss which ways the wider church and the local church can change in order to engage those who do not consider faith and church a part of their lives?

MODULE NAME : THE PRINCIPLES & Dynamics of Revival

Date: Friday 27th June 2025 Module Number: L25/08

Module Overview:

In this LAMP module you will discover what revival actually is. Much has been written about the revivals and awakenings that have taken place in the Church over many centuries. It is clear that there are a number of revival principles that constantly recur, but what are they and can they be replicated today to usher in a new revival? This module will illustrate from revival history these and other principles and explore the nature and potency of revival. The module will also introduce and look at the lives of some of the main revival protagonists.

ASPECT THREE MODULE NAME : INTRODUCTION TO ETHICS.

Module No: L25/09

Course Period: Friday Evening & Saturday Dates: Friday 5th & Saturday 6th September 2025. Format: In person for those living in Charnwood. (Online for those living further afield.) Course Fees: £40 for the weekend

Module Overview:

This module will introduce students to a number of big questions in ethics considering the nature of absolutes. It will explore how we as God's children are to determine what is right and wrong and what to do with grey areas. It will draw a contrast between the Christian view and the worldview and discuss the concept of morality and what it is? Ethics is all about doing the right thing and about becoming the right sort of person; it is also about how we act collectively, as a family, as a nation, as the human race, to improve welfare and reduce harm.

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The module will assess what these issues look like or should look like in the 21st Century. Moreover, we will discuss these views through specific case studies and explore possible strategies to address some ethical challenges that we face in current society.

ASPECT THREE

MODULE NAME : Church History Overview

Module No: L25/10

Course Period: Friday Evening & Saturday Dates: Friday 3rd & Saturday 4th October 2025. Format: In person for those living in Charnwood. (Online for those living further afield.) Course Fees: £40 for the weekend

Module Overview:

This module will familiarises students with the broad flow of church history from the early church to the present helping them to appreciate the significance of historical reflection in Christian ministry. It will consider how the gospel spread throughout the world touching on Early Church, Medieval Church and Modern Church history. It will study some key figures, events and texts throughout the centuries from church history and how those in church history have shaped various theological doctrines.

It will undoubtedly excite a passion for church history and historical theology and equip students for further study. The module will encourage students to begin to recognise how elements of their own practice and experience have been shaped by church history.

ASPECT THREE MODULE NAME: SPIRITUAL WARFARE.

Module No: L25/11

Course Period: Friday Evening & Saturday Dates: Friday 7th & Saturday 8th November 2025 Format: In person for those living in Charnwood. (Online for those living further afield.) Course Fees: £40 for the weekend

Module Overview:

This module will explore the biblical premise of spiritual warfare. The course covers the nature and characteristics of spiritual warfare and the role of God's Word and faith in spiritual battles.

The module will expose the nature and character of our enemy and how he seeks to exploit a leader's weaknesses to bring about their downfall. It will also explore the powerful weapons that God has given us to remain victorious.

It will assess how Biblical teaching can be applied to address specific problems that Christians may encounter. By the end of the course students will have a deeper understanding of spiritual warfare and be more equipped to engage in spiritual battles with confidence and faith as well as how to apply

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spiritual warfare principles in everyday life.

ASPECT THREE

MODULE NAME: HEALTHY SPIRITUALITY

Module No: L25/12

Course Period: Friday Evening & Saturday Dates: Friday 5th & Saturday 6th December 2025 Format: In person for those living in Charnwood. (Online for those living further afield.) Course Fees: £40 for the weekend

Module Overview:

The module introduces students to the subject of spirituality. Spirituality in society is an ever growing trend. There are many who don't even believe in a God but insist they are very spiritual. So what is spirituality? More to the point what constitutes healthy spirituality? The module will investigate, amongst other things, the impact of modernism, postmodernism, The New Age, modern concepts of identity, meditation, feminism, ecology and political theology on contemporary perceptions of Christian spirituality.

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This module will also explore the major disciplines in the Christian life that constitute a healthy and growing spiritual life.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

We are pleased to say that there are no formal academic entry requirements for LAMP. However, prospective students will need to complete a short application form so that we can assess suitability for the various modules.

Pastoral/Church Leadership Endorsement:

Under normal circumstances, we ask for a reference/ endorsement from your local pastor/church leader for those who want to enrol for any of our courses. That said, we appreciate under exceptional circumstances this may not be possible. So if this is the case, please contact us so we can discuss it.
